Emergency Electric Service Inspections

Repair of electric service due to damage or failure (emergency) occurring during non-business hours, may be performed by a licensed electrician without penalty provided application for permit is made the next business day. The electrician will complete and sign a form provided by Bullitt County Code Enforcement agreeing to make application for permit on the next business day. Permits for emergency, after hours inspections may be charged an additional fee above the normal permit fee.

The electric utility (Salt River, L, G & E or KU) will have the contact info for the on-call inspector. A schedule of the on-call inspectors will also be available at bcpad.net .

Planned/Scheduled Electric Service Outage Inspections (Non-emergency)

Planned interruption of electric service for service upgrades, panel replacements, service relocation etc. **must** be scheduled with Bullitt County Code Enforcement in advance. These interruptions cannot be scheduled for the last work day of the week. When application for permit is made in advance, the inspection will be scheduled including the estimated time of completion. ***It is strongly recommended to plan two inspections: 1st inspection for temporary service (temp on the main), 2nd inspection for final. Power to the structure can be reconnected much faster utilizing this method.***

Phone contact for the electrician performing the work must be on the permit. Any changes (date, time of completion) **MUST** be reported to Bullitt County Code Enforcement **immediately**.
